# Subject: Information Session on Horizon Europe Grants (17 October 2023)

As part of its Science Diplomacy outreach efforts, the Mission in collaboration with the Directorate General of Research and Innovation (DG RTD) of the European Commission is organizing a virtual information session on the <u>17<sup>th</sup></u> October 2023 from 1400 to 1630 hrs PST/1100 to 1330 hrs CET related to the access to Horizon Europe Grants.

2. Horizon Europe is the EU's key funding programme for research and innovation with a budget of  $\notin$ 95.5 billion (2021 – 2027). Pakistani researchers/institutions are eligible to apply for several Horizon Europe grant schemes. The Information Session being organized will focus on available grant calls in the following themes:

a) Agriculture

b) Circular Economy (including Sustainable Textiles)

c) Improved Disaster Risk Management and Governance

d) Mobility of Scientists – opportunities under the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions

3. The Information Session will also include a general introduction to the Horizon Europe grant scheme and modalities of participation of Pakistani institutions. This will be an extremely useful opportunity for our research institutions, higher education institutions as well as our scientific diaspora in the EU.

4. The focus areas during the information session are also highly relevant for Pakistan's research and innovation related requirements. This interaction will

enable institutionalizing Pakistan's knowledge partnerships with the EU and open up new collaborative ventures. <u>A copy of the program is also being enclosed for</u> information which includes the registration link for the event.

- 5. The following is requested from the addressed stakeholders:
  - The Higher Education Commission is requested to share the information about the event with all relevant educational institutions and research organizations in its database, especially with relevance to the thematic areas. HEC's active participation is also sought in the event to facilitate future interaction with the European Commission.
  - The Ministry of Science and Technology is requested to share the information about the event with relevant research organizations within its mandate.
  - Ministry of Foreign Affairs is requested to share the information about the activity with the Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission.
  - Missions in the EU are requested to share the information with the scientific diaspora in the EU. Their participation can help create linkages between EU and Pakistani institutions for grant applications.
