






FDA CUI

Assessment for Online Learning

FDA arranged a workshop on 'Assessment for Online Learning' on March 15, 2022. Dr Shazia Awan (AP LUMS) was the trainer of this workshop. This One-day workshop was held virtually. A total of 111 participants attended the workshop. The purpose of this



webinar was to explore online assessments tools and how to design online assessment effectively by ensuring the alignment between learning objectives and students understanding.

Innovation & Entrepreneurship for Startups for Faculty & Students

Faculty Development Academy organized a seminar on 'Innovation & Entrepreneurship for Startups for Faculty & Students' for CUI Islamabad campus. This two-hour seminar was arranged on June 21, 2022. Mr. Mohammad Umer Kamal, a renowned entrepreneur with diversified experience in fundraising

Enhancing Teaching Excellence

2023 ACTIVITIES

Outcome Based Education (OBE)

Outcome Based Education – CUI Sahiwal Campus

FDA organized One day Training on 'Outcome Based Education' at CUI Sahiwal Campus on February 27, 2023. Prof. Dr. Junaid Mughal, Director CUI Attock campus was the resource person for this training. The workshop focused on Outcome Based Education, as an integral part of teaching and learning with an emphasis on its effective use, to enhance student performance and improve their practical understanding. The



workshop was specifically designed for CUI teachers to equip them with a clear understanding of the OBE model, its advantages and limitations. There were 137 participants altogether.





Outcome Based Education – CUI Vehari Campus

One day Training on Outcome Based Education at CUI Vehari Campus was held on February 28, 2023. Prof. Dr. Junaid Mughal, Director CUI Attock campus conducted the training. The training had two sessions; first, theoretical session was delivered by the domain expert and later a practicum session



was conducted. There were 150 participants in all.



Outcome Based Education – CUI Lahore Campus

Faculty Development Academy organized 2-day training on Outcome Based Education at CUI Lahore Campus on March 20-21, 2023. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Junaid Mughal, Director CUI Attock campus, rendered his services as a resource person. OBE is a model that needs reoccurrence due to the requirement of changing times. OBE is more



satisfying than the Traditional Teaching and it requires that students demonstrate that they have learned the required skills and content.

There were around 35 participants from different departments of CUI Lahore campus.



Outcome Based Education – CUI Abbottabad Campus

The series of OBE was conducted at CUI Abbottabad Campus on August 9, 2023. OBE is a recurring reform model, it focuses on outcome that is measuring student performance. OBE contrasts with traditional education, which primarily focused on the resources available to the student, called inputs. The sessions were delivered successfully by Prof. Dr. Junaid Mughal,



Director CUI Attock campus, and there were 67 participants.





Workshop on Basic Social Media Tools/Beyond the #Hashtag

Faculty Development Academy, in collaboration with Registrar office, organized a 1-day training on 'Basic Social Media Tools/Beyond the #Hashtag' on June 8, 2023. The workshop was arranged in SSBC and there were 31 participants from different departments of CUI Islamabad.


