



- a) The approved Scheme of Studies of all undergraduate programs are available in the Registrar Office of the respective campus.

Admissions

Admission to various degree programs at CIIT is open to all eligible candidates without discrimination of any kind and with equal opportunities for al; hence all admissions are regulated on the basis of merit.

Application Procedure

Applications are made in response to the admission notices in the press. Admissions are conducted according to an admission schedule, which is prominently displayed in these admissions notices. The procedure consists of following steps:

1) Online Admission Application

- Candidates are required to apply on CIIT Online Admission System by following the link http://admissions.comsats.edu.pk. o Note: For Virtual Campus, please visit http://admissions.comsats.edu.pk/vc
- After submitting the online application, the printed copy of the same along with the required documents, as mentioned in Online Admission Portal, must be submitted at the concerned Campus either by hand or mail. Candidate may mention three program preferences for admission on one application form.
 Note: Applicants seeking admission in Virtual Campus can submit their documents in selected study center or can post the document to Virtual Campus secretariat in Islamabad.
- In case the final result of previous examination is awaited, then provision of a Hope Certificate'/affidavits (if applicable), from the school/college last attended can provide the basis for a conditional offer of admission at CIT. The offer is confirmed once the final result is declared and eligibility criteria are fully met. A specimen of a 'Hope Certificate' is available on the Admission portal.
- Admission applications must be submitted before or by due date of submission. Late submission shall not be entertained.
- Candidates must check the eligibility criteria before submitting their online application forms to confirm that they are academically eligible for admission into the program of their choice.

2) Entrance Test

After the last date of submission of Admission Forms, entrance tests (NAT) will be conducted by NTS according to the admission schedule OR on a given date as notified by NTS through their website www.nts.org.pk and the print media. All admissions shall be regulated on the basis of merit determined by the weightage oriteria as mentioned below:

Note: For Dual Degree applicants, an IELTS score of at least 5.5 band is also required for Lancaster University Degree.

The additional admission criterion for B.Arch and B.Des programs

is as below:

- 30% weightage of General merit (including matric, intermediate and NTS score)
- 50% weightage of Drawing Test.
- 20% weightage of Interview

3) Merit List

A list of shortlisted candidates is displayed on specified dates on the campus notice boards as well as on the CIIT website by the respective Admissions Offices. However, applicants are urged to make a pro-active effort to know the status of their application for admission by either visiting the concerned campus or CIIT's website.

4) Interview

Shortlisted candidates along with parents/guardians may be asked to appear for interviews in respective departments to ascertain their suitability in the program in which admission is being sought.

5) Verification of Documents

Shortlisted candidates will be asked to bring the following documents to the Admissions Office for verification within a specified time frame:

- Original Certificates/ Detailed Mark Sheets of matric or equivalent examination, intermediate or equivalent examination, and graduate degree or its equivalent examination (if applicable), with two attested photocopies of each.
- Original Equivalence Certificate along with two attested photocopies.
- Original Migration Certificate along with two photocopies (if applicable).
- Original Hope Certificate with two attested photocopies or Affidavit (if applicable).
- Undertaking, on Stamp Paper, by the student and guardian to abide by the rules and regulations of the institute (pattern is given in the prospectus).
- National Identity Card (or 'B' Form) along with two attested photocopies.
- Two passport size photographs. These must be attested from the back of the photograph. Also the name, guardian's name, and program applied for should be clearly printed on the back of the photographs.

6) Display of Merit List and Admission Offer Letter

The final merit list is displayed on the departmental notice boards as well as on CIIT website. After initial scrutiny of the documents, selected candidate will be issued "Admission Offer Letter" along with a Bank Challan Form for payment of dues.

7) Provisional Admissions

Candidates applying on the basis of Hope Certificate are provisionally admitted and must ensure that their results are received in the admission office of concerned campus within 20 teaching days after the commencement of the semestar; otherwise their admission will be cancelled. Those getting admission on Hope Certificate/Affidavit, if could not obtain the minimum qualifying marks or failed to submit in time the equivalence certificate of foreign qualification/examination, on the basis of which they applied for admission shall have no right to continue their studies and their admissions shall stand cancelled whenever identified.

8) Acceptance of Admission Offer

Selected candidates are required to confirm their acceptance of admission by paying the non-refundable admission and tultion fee within the specified dates. Admission process will only be completed after the payment of fee is confirmed and all the desired documents have been submitted, verified and candidate has been found eligibile for admission. If candidates fail to confirm enrolment by the given deadline, selection will stand canceled and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list.

International Students

CIIT welcomes international students to join it to enrich the diversity of the campus community and to promote international understanding and global awareness. CIIT offers admission in various programs at undergraduate and graduate level at all CIIT campuses.

The international students may apply on online admission portal, besides the general route self-finance applicants may also send their applications for admission in undergraduate degree programs directly to CIIT Office of International Students Affairs (OISA), Park Road, Islamabad, Pakistan by mail and scanned copies on email address to: int.admissions@comsats.edu.pk. However, all international students applying to the CIIT for admissions must demonstrate that they are competent in the use of English language and satisfy the institute's requirements for English language. CIIT accepts the following qualifications as satisfying the English Language requirements for entry to an undergraduate academic degree program:

- English Proficiency Certificate from the Last attended Institution OR
- IELTS minimum 5.0 band OR
- TOEFL Internet-based test overall minimum score 70

Furthermore, in view of differences in educational systems of different countries, applicants will have to submit an equivalence certificate obtainable from the inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC) Pakistan http://www.ibcc.edu.pk/ and/or from Higher Education Commission of Pakistan (HEC) www.hec.gov.pk while applying for admission in undergraduate and graduate programs respectively. For this purpose applicants can either contact to international Admission Office of CIT or can apply directly to the said offices. CIIT hostel accommodation is also available for international students. The Office of International Students Affairs (OISA) will act as a focal point to extend help and support during international students' stay at CIIT, Pakistan, and shall also provide assistance for visa and immigrations requisites. The OISA also invite to attend and participate in a wide range of social and cultural events.

Financial Support

CIIT is offering various types of financial support to the candidates admitted in the degree programs on purely merit basis but are inable to pay their fee expenses. The CIIT under the 'Financial Support Programs (FSPs), financially supports various categories of students in the form of financial support, scholarships and stipends. The institute takes special care of its deprived students and not only gives them eminent education but also keeps a bird's eye on their financial concerns and plays vital role to resolve them so that the students may not face any obstacle in the way of education. Financial Assistance is available to all students who prove to be needy regardless of race, religion, color, national origin, age, sex, or handicap. The various types of Financiar Assistance Programs are as follows:

1. Need Based Financial Support Program (NBFSP)

- HEC Need-Based Scholarships
- National ICT R&D Fund Scholarships
- French Need-Based Scholarships

2. Financial Assistance Program

- CIITEF Scholarships
- Punjab Education Endowment Fund (PEEF) Scholarship
- 30% seats reserved in each discipline for the children of Punjab Workers Welfare Board at Lahore campus (except Dual Degree Program)
- · For walk in needy students

3. CIIT Financial Support Program: Qarz-e-Hasna The needy students may also apply for Qarz-e-Hasna which is implemented under CIIT Qarz-e-Hasna Rules, 2012. A student granted admission on merit through normal course, is not an employee anywhare, and he/she or his/her parents/guardian are financially unable to pay the fees and he /she cannot purse studies due to financial constraints can benefit under this financial support. The maximum pariod for complete repayment of the Qarz-Hasna is Ten years from the day of disbursement of first instalment. Further details and pre-requisities may be obtained from campus admission offices.

4. CIIT Pecuniary Program (CPP)

(a) Kinship / Siblings Pecuniary

When two or more siblings are concurrently students of CIIT, the siblings will be financially supported. A financial support of upto Rs. 8,000/- per semester will be provided to all the siblings provided the parents cannot afford to pay the fee and the students show good academic performance. Such cases will be decided by the Financial Support Program Committee (FSPC) at respective Campus.

(b) CIIT Employees' Pecuniary

CIIT provides financial support to the children/wards (including step children, legally adopted children), of a CIIT employee, who got admission in CIIT on merit. A financial support equal to the tuition fee will be provided to the student. The financial support provided will be unconditional, irrespective of performance of the student and study period of the degree. This support, however, will not be given to the child/ward, of the employee, if he/she himself/herself is employed, and for the professional degrees such as MPM, MEM and other similar programs.

5. Academic Excellence Recognition Program

Students who demonstrate academic excellence by achieving outstanding positions (First Three) at the end of the semester in each degree program on a campus shall be awarded merit certificates.


