The Prize honors individuals, institutions or NGOs that have made outstanding contributions in the field of microbiology (including immunology, molecular biology, genetics and applications).

<u>Self-nominations will not be considered.</u> The nominations should be submitted by the governments of Member States, in consultation with their National Commissions, or by non-governmental organizations (NGOs) maintaining official partnerships with UNESCO. The Member State will get access to an online platform, where the nomination form and the written recommendation (including points a-c) can be uploaded. Alternatively, the Member State can send both the nomination form and the Prize via email of the Secretariat written recommendation to the (carlosifinlayprize@unesco.org).

For nomination by non-governmental organizations (NGOs) in official partnership with UNESCO:
