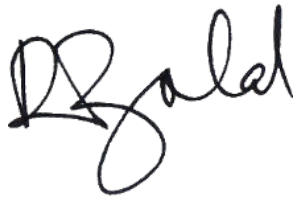

What sets apart Global Town Hall from other discussions is our robust North-South-East-West spirit, where we ensure the inclusion of speakers and discussants from all parts of the world, as we are keen to hear everyone’s perspectives. With the world facing intersectoral crises, Global Town Hall provides a venue for action-oriented discussions, many of them tied to Global Citizen’s global campaigns.

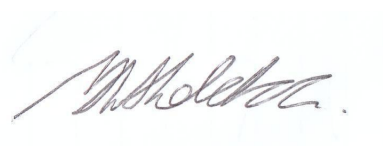
