This Joint Student Camp sets out to establish a platform for high-potential students to network and exchange ideas across cultures. The program aims to unite a focused group of students from diverse ethnicities and nationalities to gather with Iranian students particularly from Islamic Azad University of Isfahan.



The program will invite a select group of students from participating university (COMSATS University Islamabad) to visit the IAU Isfahan and encourage further academic cooperation between both countries. This program will concentrated on subjects such as economy, scientific, culture,

and education in bilateral relations, as well as inter-regional cooperation between countries in the Asia. The Camp will help to propel this agenda by empowering selected students, from both universities to have access to prestigious educational training and intellectual exchange with one another.

Curriculum Development and Academic Expertise

The camp will center collaboration with academic institutions to design a comprehensive one week program where four (4) topics will be discussed with one (1) topic each day. This camp includes study tours, workshops, and seminars on the region's history, culture, economy, and science. Each side will present their distinguished professors and propose their workshop topics.of study.

- Each side commits to promoting cultural exchange and academic excellence.
- IAU Isfahan handle logistics in Isfahan for 20 students, 4 leaderships and speakers, covering accommodation, meals, and local transportation and related expenses of in Iran and Isfahan.
- IAU Isfahan will pay whole costs for Workshops, 7- day accommodation, specialized visits.
- (Note: If, for any reason, your stay exceeds 7 days, any mentioned expenses should be paid by your own.)
- IAU Isfahan by Collaborating with local organizations in Isfahan will organize cultural, historical, industrial and scientific visits to deepen all camp participants' regional understanding.
- COMSATS University as content planner for Pakistani students, manages logistics in Pakistan, including flight arrangements for participants and speakers.
- Each side can own their sponsors regarding the expenses that incurs.
