

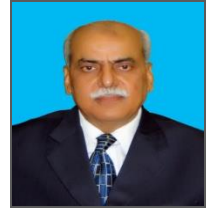
Maj Gen (R) Prof. Dr. Muhammad Aslam

Maj.Gen (retd.) Professor Muhammad Aslam is the current Vice Chancellor of University of Health Sciences Lahore. He is the third vice chancellor of UHS. A graduate of Nishtar Medical College Multan, Prof Aslam's area of specialization is physiology with special interest in reproductive endocrinology and high altitude physiology.

Prof Aslam did his MPhil from Postgraduate Medical Institute Lahore in 1982 and did PhD in Physiology from St.Thomas's Hospital Medical School, University of London, UK in 1987. He is also a fellow of Pakistan Academy of Medical Sciences and College of Physicians and Surgeons of Pakistan.

Prof. Aslam has more than 35 years' experience in teaching and research at both undergraduate and postgraduate level. He has served as the Principal of Army Medical College Rawalpindi, Dean, Faculty of Medicine, National University of Sciences & Technology (NUST) Rawalpindi, Principal of Shifa College of Medicine Islamabad, and also as Vice Chancellor, Shifa Tameer-e-Millat University, Islamabad.

Prof. Aslam has more than 120 publications to his credit. He is a recipient of several honours and awards including Hilal-i-Imtiaz (Military), President Gold Medal for Best University Teacher (2006-07), Best University Teacher Award (2005) by Higher Education Commission of Pakistan and Productive Scientist of Pakistan Award (2007) by Pakistan Council for Science and Technology.
