Prof. Dr. Amin U. Sarkar joined as Vice Chancellor of North South University (NSU), Bangladesh, on June 11, 2013. After his Ph.D. and MA from the University of California at Berkeley, he served for 25 years in the U.S. as an economics professor and an academic administrator. He was Dean of the Alabama A&M University's College of Business & Public Affairs for six years, Dean of the Black Hills State University's College of Business & Technology for three years, Chairman of the Georgia College & State University's Dept. of Economics, Finance & Marketing for three years, and Chairman of the State University of New York (SUNY) at Fredonia's Dept. of Economics for four years.

Dr. Sarkar received leadership training of Stanford University in 2006, Cornell University & New York State United University Professions in 2001, and SUNY in 1998. He introduced standardized American master's degrees and a broad-based undergraduate curriculum at NSU. He also prepared two U.S. business schools for the AACSB accreditation.
